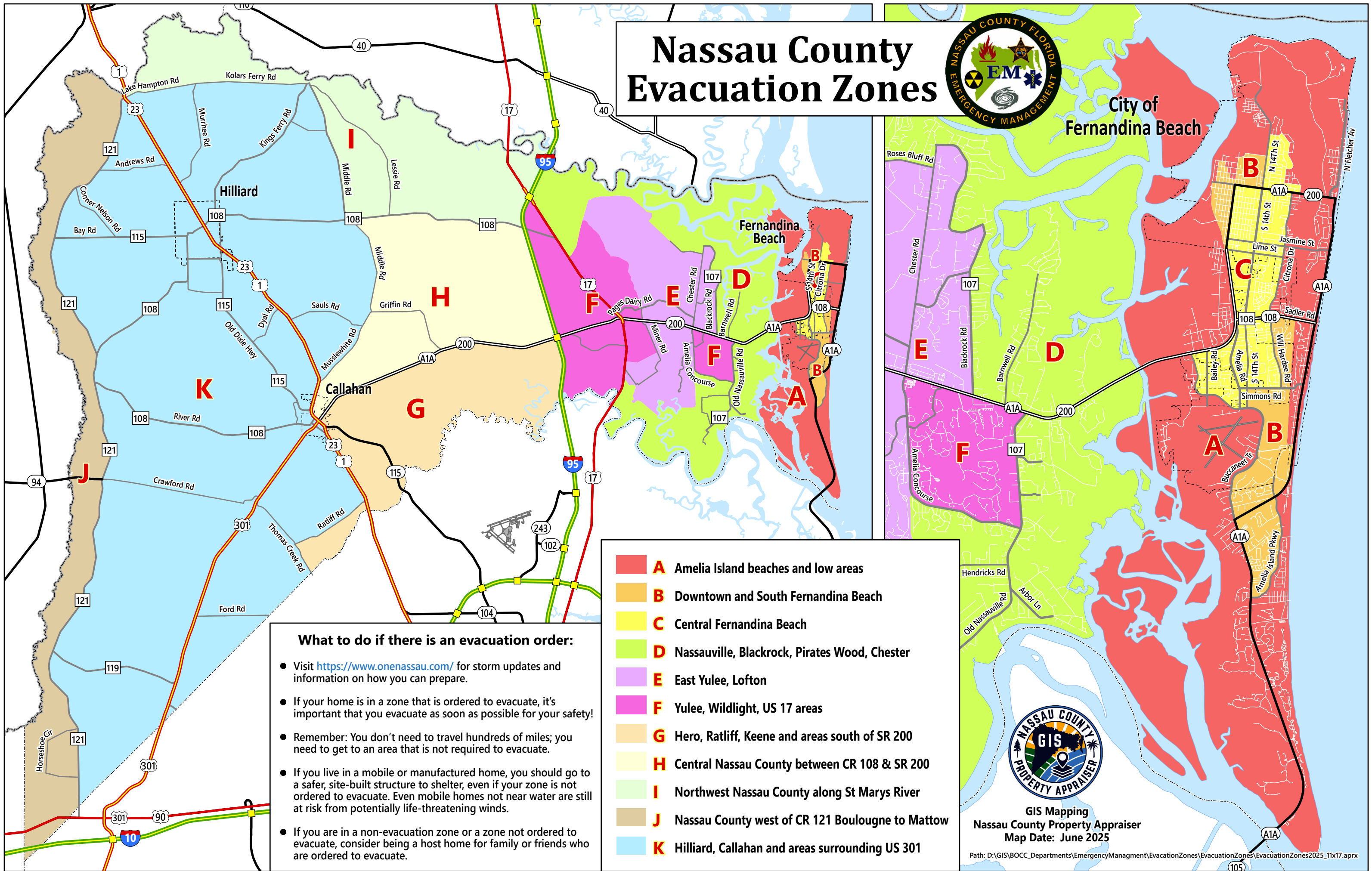


Nassau County Evacuation Zones

What to do if there is an evacuation order:

- Visit <https://www.onenassau.com/> for storm updates and information on how you can prepare.
- If your home is in a zone that is ordered to evacuate, it's important that you evacuate as soon as possible for your safety!
- Remember: You don't need to travel hundreds of miles; you need to get to an area that is not required to evacuate.
- If you live in a mobile or manufactured home, you should go to a safer, site-built structure to shelter, even if your zone is not ordered to evacuate. Even mobile homes not near water are still at risk from potentially life-threatening winds.
- If you are in a non-evacuation zone or a zone not ordered to evacuate, consider being a host home for family or friends who are ordered to evacuate.
